10 FUN FACTS ABOUT DUBROVNIK

Lord Byron described Dubrovnik as the 'jewel of the Adriatic' and its bewitching mystery and beauty led George Bernard Shaw to consider its sublime setting as a 'paradise on earth.'

The architecture of Dubrovnik has long been regarded with wonder, not least by those who are inspired by the rich history it evokes. Invaders, travellers, monarchs and writers have waxed lyrical about the beauty of this marbled city, hidden behind medieval stone walls whose warmth in the sun perhaps belies the strength they offer to all those who live within them. You can walk along the wide marble streets, visit Baroque buildings, revel in a past which reflects Roman, Byzantium and Venetian influences, retrace Napoleon's steps as you marvel at the beauty of the city and enjoy Dubrovnik's chic European lifestyle.

Wind your way through the cobbled side streets or stride along the main street, the Stradun, and sooner or later your path will lead you to one of the various squares in the Old City. A typical medieval city with large open spaces, needed for public and private business, the Old City is living proof of harmonious urban planning.

And although you might think you've heard everything about Dubrovnik, here are some interesting history facts we are sure you didn't know about:

1. Until 1808 Dubrovnik's official name was Ragusa
2. The Republic of Dubrovnik was the first state in the world to recognise the United States of America (in 1776)
3. Dubrovnik City Walls have never been breached
4. World's third oldest, still functioning, pharmacy is located in Dubrovnik
5. The Republic of Dubrovnik officially banned slavery 600 years ago
6. Dubrovnik had the first orphanage in the world
7. Dubrovnik has a medieval sewer system dating from 1296 which is still in use today
8. Dubrovnik's Insurance Law is the oldest in Europe (validated in 1395)
9. Dubrovnik had some colonies, interestingly, one of those was in a village called Gandaulim, in Old Goa, India - The Church of St. Blaise still stands there today
10. At the time of the Dubrovnik Republic when wind jugo was blowing, no important political decisions could be made

A GUIDE TO DUBROVNIK'S HIDDEN GEMS

There are incredible landmarks known worldwide though not everything in this unique city has been fully discovered. Don't miss an unforgettable, most exciting and unusual locations! Here are some of the hidden gems that are just waiting to be explored.

Park Orsula

Set high on a cliff 200 metres above the sea, Park Orsula offers a magnificent natural setting with stunning views of Dubrovnik's historic Old Town and the island of Lokrum. In addition, it is also known as a recently restored archaeological site featuring chapel of St. Orsula, from the 14th century. This viewpoint certainly rivals the renowned Mountain Srđ.



Open Air Cinema

During the summer, open air cinemas pop around the city. In the beautiful setting of the Old Town discover Jadran Open-Air Cinema or take a short stroll from Pile Gate to Boninovo and visit Slavica Open-Air Cinema. Along with some big releases and blockbusters enjoy Croatian and European films or take a part in educational programmes, presentations and workshops.

Secluded Swimming Spots

Dubrovnik is well-known for its crystal-clear Adriatic Sea. If you would like to escape the everyday, discover the glorious island of Koločep that floats on the Adriatic Sea directly opposite the Sun Gardens Dubrovnik and visit the Blue Cave. The cave itself is in a bay you can easily anchor in, and swim through the blue sea.

Dubrovnik is one of the world's most iconic tourist cities in the world, but how does it shape up as an experience for children?

Welcome to Dubrovnik, which guarantees fun, fun, fun for the little ones!

Fun starts at home, of course, and Sun Gardens Dubrovnik family resort is a children's paradise. Dubrovnik itself is a fascinating old town to explore through young eyes. If Kings Landing in Game of Thrones can excite the imagination of adult fans, just



imagine how much kids will enjoy discovering the hidden streets and squares of this magical city.

Time to descend and head to the beach for some serious swimming and chilling. Banje beach is close to the old town, of course, but why not head off – as the locals so – to Lokrum Island and find a less crowded swimming opportunity. There are plenty of boats for further Elaphite hopping.

Looking to get a little more active? There are some fantastic sea-kayaking tours available, where you can kayak close to the walls and around the nearby islands. Take the sunset tour, a truly unforgettable family experience.

Children activities are not confined to Dubrovnik if you are staying at Sun Gardens Dubrovnik. There are several great trips a short distance away. Among the best is Trsteno, a magnificent arboretum, the biggest in Croatia and another treasure trove of magic to explore. Or drive a little further to Ston and visit the largest salt pans in the region. The kids may not be partial to the famous oysters of Mali Ston, but they will certainly enjoy the boat ride to the floating oyster bar and learn the whole process of oyster cultivation.

CROATIAN INVENTIONS

Did you know that Croatia is home of many inventors? And while today Croatia is one of the hottest tourist destinations going by Croatia – Full of life slogan, have you ever stopped to consider how much your everyday life is full of Croatia?

From the one and only Nikola Tesla to contemporary genius Mate Rimac, here are some of the Croatian inventors and their inventions - some of which we are sure you are using on a day to day basis.

NIKOLA TESLA

With around 300 patents for his many inventions Nikola Tesla is one of the greatest inventors of the modern age. Today, Tesla is perhaps best known for inventing the first alternating current (AC) motor and developed AC generation and transmission technology. If you have time, visit a thematic Memorial centre set in his birthplace - the village Smiljan, found in the interior of Dalmatia near the town Gospić.

PENCIL

Now here is one that we are sure you didn't know about! Among many Croatian inventions Slavoljub Penkala gave the world, he is most famous for inventing the first mechanical pencil in 1906, as well as the first solid-ink fountain pen in 1907.

THE TIE

There is no doubt that one of the well-known Croatian inventions is the necktie. The story goes back to Paris in 1630 and to King Louis XIII, impressed with traditional costume by Croatian mercenaries. In the streets of Paris and other cities, the cravat quickly became the hottest fashion accessory.



QUARANTINE

Welcome to The Republic of Ragusa (The Dubrovnik Republic), the first place in the world to introduce the concept of quarantine. In 1377, The Republic issued a decree for all newcomers who lived abroad to spend 40 days at one of the nearby islands before entering the city. It was the first such decision in the world and is now considered the quarantine was originally a Dubrovnik invention. Afterwards, in 1627 it was decided to build a new quarantine – Lazareti, at the east entrance to the city.

ELECTRIC LIGHT-BULB WITH A METAL FILAMENT

Franjo Hanaman was the famous Croatian chemist and metallurgist and inventor of the first cost-effective electric light bulb with a metal filament. It was patented in 1903! Light bulb filament which is still used and which replaced the bulb with carbon filament was a turning point in the production of lighting fixtures!

ATHOMIC THEORY

Ruđer Bošković produced a precursor of atomic theory and made many contributions to astronomy. These included the first geometric procedure for determining the equator of a rotating planet from three observations of a surface feature and for computing the orbit of a planet from three observations of its position. In 1753 he also discovered the absence of atmosphere on the Moon.

MATE RIMAC

Mate Rimac is one of the greats contemporary Croatian inventors. His company Rimac Automobili has taken the global car industry by storm, attracting multi-million dollar investment from the likes of Porsche in the process. We are sure that we will hear more of him in the future!

EAT LOCAL – 6 DUBROVNIK REGIONAL CLASSICS NOT TO MISS

In an increasingly globalised world, tourists are looking for authenticity and individuality, both in the tourist experience and in the food on holiday. And if you find yourself in this category, congratulations – you have come to the right place, Dubrovnik!

There is no need to take about the uniqueness of the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the Old Town of Dubrovnik, but what is lesser known is the richness, freshness and localness of the cuisine of the Dubrovnik region. There are a number of dishes which have not only been handed down by grandmothers throughout the ages, but which also have a little history of its own.

Dirty Macaroni (Špori Makaruli) perhaps does not have the most appealing name in English, but it is delicious and much loved locally. So much so in fact that it is often served on the feast day of the city's beloved patron saint St Blaise in early February. Its history dates back to aristocratic times when the best of the meat was eaten, and the remaining meat sauce was mixed with macaroni and fed to the servants.

Mušule na buzaru (Stewed mussels) is another dish not to be missed. The mussels in the Adriatic (and also don't miss the famous oysters of Mali Ston) are of excellent quality and a popular dish in the city. The most popular way to serve them is 'na buzaru' (in a stew), cooked in olive oil, wine, garlic, breadcrumbs and fresh herbs.

The walled town of Ston (a short drive from Sun Gardens Dubrovnik) may be famous for those

oysters, its incredible walls and the largest salt pans in the region, but it also boast a fantastic and rather unusual dessert – the Stonska torta (Ston cake). It is a hard one to describe, but let's just say that it is both sweet and savoury, containing both chocolate and macaroni pasta, known locally as makaruli. One not to miss as you pass through Ston.

Another famous local stew is Dubrovačka zelena menestra (Green Stew). Its written origins date back as far as 1480, and there are several regional variations. It is thought the Konavle, to the south of the city, is where the dish originated, and there is an annual Green Stew Cooking competition there each year over the Christmas period. The stew has green elements of cabbage and kale, as well as bacon and sausage.

Simplicity and freshness of local ingredients are at the heart of Dalmatian cuisine, and many dishes were designed for the workers who could not afford the luxuries of meat or fish. Bob and blitva podulje is one such dish which is very popular and celebrates the healthy nature of the Mediterranean Diet, which was inscribed as intangible UNESCO heritage back in 2013. Broad beans, Swiss chard and olive oil. Healthy simplicity at its most perfect.

Desserts, too, can be made from the simplest of ingredients but be full of flavour, such as the traditional cake Padišpanj. It derives its name from Pan di Spagna (Spanish bread) and so presumably came to Dubrovnik via its sailors. A soft sponge cake, whose ingredients are eggs, flour, sugar, salt, baking powder and oil.

In a globalised world, Dubrovnik is a beacon of unique customs, heritage, culture and traditions. You can also add food to the list. Which Dubrovnik dish will you be trying?
