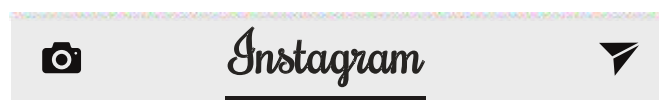

BUILDING DUBROVNIK'S WEALTH: THE WHITE GOLD OF STON

Drive north of Dubrovnik, and after a while you will come to a fascinating little town at the entrance to the Pelješac Peninsula: Ston.

Your first impression will be the striking fortified walls which snake up around the rising hill of the peninsula, a fascinating stone wall construction of more than 5km in length, which is said to be the longest fortified wall outside of China. Stop for lunch at nearby Mali Ston, and you will enjoy one of the great true local culinary treasures of Croatia – the famous oysters of Ston, now complete with its very own annual oyster festival.

But the real story which first put Ston on the world map, necessitated the building of that amazing wall, and which gave the Dubrovnik Republic most of its wealth was something altogether different – white gold, otherwise known as salt.

For Ston's original claim to fame lies in the fact that it has the oldest salt pans in Europe, pans that were deemed too important to the economic wellbeing of the Dubrovnik Republic that Ston's famous walls were built in the 14th and 15th century to protect this valuable commodity, a commodity which brought approximate one third of its wealth to the Dubrovnik Republic.



Little has changed in the harvesting methods today, and Ston's salt continues to be an important source of revenue, with some 500 tons of salt harvested annually. The process needs only the help of three natural factors, as it did all those years ago – the sun, the sea and the wind. The salt pans consist of 58 pools, which are divided into five groups, as production has to go through five stages over a course of 1-2 months. The final group of pools deals with the crystallisation of the salt, and 8 of the 9 pools are named after saints (Francis, Nicholas, Balthazar, Anthony, Joseph, John, Peter and Paul). Harvesting normally takes place in the warmer months, from April until October.



Tourism has entered the history of Ston salt in recent years. A museum is being built and Ston held its first salt festival this summer. If you would like to try your hand as a salt harvester, the town runs a volunteer summer camp from the middle of July until September, where one pool is harvested daily. Camp participants are given appropriate clothing, free accommodation, and some rather unusual perks, such as the opportunity to play volleyball in salt. You can't do that back home!

The salt from the pans of Ston is just one more example of the high quality natural and local produce available in and around Dubrovnik, a major factor in the excellence of Dalmatian cuisine. A day trip to Ston is a fascinating option for guests looking to explore – a chance to hike the longest fortified wall in Europe, from where the views of the continent's oldest salt pans are particularly splendid, then finish with an oyster feast on the water in Mali Ston. Just one of the many fabulous excursions available during your stay at Sun Gardens Dubrovnik.

DELICATE SUMMER TASTE: FIGS

There are few healthier symbols of the Dalmatian lifestyle than figs. Not only are fig trees everywhere in the region, but they appear in almost every aspect of daily life – as medicine, rakija and a variety of dishes.

With over 800 different sorts of fig, there is plenty of choice, and figs are best eaten straight from the tree. It is said that the first figs were planted in California by immigrants from Korčula, although a stronger theory is that the first figs came earlier from Spain. What is true is that you will rarely see a Dalmatian too far from a fig tree!

There are no organised fig plantations as such, and fig trees mostly grow wild all over the region, often in olive groves, but their taste is delicious. They can be enjoyed fresh from the trees in the summer months, but they are also preserved so that they can be enjoyed all yearround.

In order to do that, the picked figs need to be dried. After picking, they are washed and then laid out on a wooden board and exposed to that ubiquitous Dalmatian sun, being turned daily until they turn a golden brown. They can then be frozen in bags and enjoyed whenever the moment is right. The drying process usually takes place in August.

As with many Dalmatian fruits and herbs, figs have great health benefits, some proven and some old Dalmatian wives' tales. They are good for an energy boost, for example, as well as a cure for a sore throat. Rich in fibre, they help with constipation, and if you have a skin irritation, what can be better than rubbing a fig on the skin?

While fresh figs from the tree is the easiest way to enjoy them, figs appear in many different forms in the Dalmatian lifestyle. Unsurprisingly in a region with the motto 'if it grows, we will make rakija from it' many figs are transformed into rakija. Rakija smokovača is one of the most delicious types of strong liquor you will try in Dalmatia or anywhere else.

Also, one of the most popular uses is in the very popular Dalmatian Fig Spread, a health and tasty addition to any sandwich. The spread has a shelf life of 3 years unopened, and 3-4 weeks refrigerated once opened. And fig jam is delicious, especially when made to homemade recipes, where you will find every family claiming that their fig jam is the best in the region.

Dalmatia is blessed with a rich selection of natural herbs, vegetables or fruit which contribute to the Mediterranean Diet which achieved intangible UNESCO heritage status in 2013. Along with olives, figs are at the heart of that goodness. The only question remains – how will you be taking your figs on your next trip to Dubrovnik?

CROATIAN WINES YOU HAVE TO TRY

Location, location, location. In addition to its idyllic waterfront setting and close proximity to historic Dubrovnik, Sun Gardens Dubrovnik is also ideally positioned to discover some of Croatia's finest wines. The story about Croatian wine is rather fascinating, with more international experts praising the unique contribution they are making to the wine world. With more than 130 indigenous varieties, there is plenty to discover and here are our sommelier recommendations:

Malvasija Tezoro, Crvik, Konavle

Head a little south of Dubrovnik to the fascinating region of Konavle, with its ancient traditions and way of life, where the rare Dubrovnik Malvasia is king of the whites. Malvasija Dubrovačka is mature, warm, large, complex, solid, harmonious wine for top quality food. Crvik's Malvasija Tezoro got her name from a quotation from Držić's piece where "tezoro" is (treasure).

Dingač Vicelić, Pelješac

The Pelješac Peninsula is home to the best wines of this excellent variety. Vicelić is a boutique winery with a current production of 10 000 bottles of premium brand „Dingac“ wine. Dingač premium quality, fascinating, rich red wine is characterized by fruits, dark cherry, blackberry and plum, entertaining bouquet with richness of sugar. Nuanced spices and oak barrels supported by solid, but ripe tannin structure.

Rose Korta Katarina, Pelješac

Tasting Korta Katarina wines is certainly a very special experience. Mild pink hue, with an intense scent of red berries and roses aroma. Freshly dry flavour, with prevailing aromas of strawberry, raspberry, and cherry. Medium body, balanced, with the mild finish!


