

DISCOVER THE DUBROVNIK REGION

You only have to look out of the window of your room at Sun Gardens Dubrovnik to realise that you are currently in one of the most beautiful places in the world.

The crystal, clear Adriatic Sea lapping around your toes, the Elaphite islands glittering on the horizon and the lush Mediterranean countryside surrounding you, this is heaven on earth. Now is the time to explore and discover your own slice of splendour. And believe us, the Dubrovnik region is fascinating, and one which encourages you to explore.

GAME OF THRONES

A television series which surely needs no introduction. The hit HBO series has forever linked the Pearl of the Adriatic to a new mythical name – King's Landing. Several series of the global blockbuster were shot on site in Dubrovnik, and tens of thousands of GoT fans flock to the city each year to visit the filming locations that were beamed around the globe. Walk the streets of the magnificent King's Landing, the very capital of Westeros, with your private guide who will take you not only to the locations but also the inside stories of the Battle of Blackwater Bay, the attack on King Joffrey and royal family by angry citizens and the famous Queen Cersei's walk of shame. To highlight your Game of Thrones experience, visit Trsteno Arboretum, one of the oldest arboretums in Croatia only a short drive away from our resort, and the beautiful island of Lokrum, just a few minutes boat-ride from the Old City harbour.





STON & PELJEŠAC

Less than 45-minutes from Sun Gardens Dubrovnik, visit one of Dalmatia's most picturesque destinations. At the entrance to the Pelješac Peninsula discover a fascinating little town: Ston. Your first impression will be the striking fortified walls which snake up around the rising hill of the peninsula, a fascinating stone wall construction of more than 5km in length, which is said to be the longest fortified wall outside of China. Stop for lunch at nearby Mali Ston, and you will enjoy one of the great true local culinary treasures of Croatia – the famous oysters of Ston. Napoleon built a road through the heart of the peninsula 200 years ago, a road which today allows you to drive through the famous Dingač vineyards, which enjoying stunning sea views both right and left. On your way through Pelješac, stop in one such vineyard for an authentic Dalmatian wine experience. Then continue on to an altogether different part of Dalmatian life in the sleepy fishing village of Trpanj, where a traditional Dalmatian tavern is waiting to offer you the very freshest catch of the day.




SAILING OFF THE ELAFITI ISLANDS

The 13 islands that make up the Elafiti archipelago -Elafiti comes from the Greek word 'elafos' or deer are perfect for a summer afternoon of sailing. Whether you choose to travel on a historically reconstructed galleon complete with costumed crew and snacks, or jump on one of the party boats during the Summer Festival, spending the day with the warm breeze in your hair and the sparkling sea below must be one of life's greatest pleasures. Only three of the islands are inhabited - Šipan, Lopud, Koločep - and their beautiful shorelines are rich in maritime and natural variety. The ten remaining islets - Crkvina, Daksa, Golec, Jakljan, Cosmic, Misnjak, Olipa, Sveti Andrija, Ruda and Tajan. The islands are filled with pine forests, cliffs, caves, reefs and beaches. Even the populated islands have less than 200 inhabitants each, preserving their beauty.

CAVTAT

Medieval churches, tight cobbled streets, manicured gardens, palm-lined promenades and bobbing fishing boats, Cavtat epitomises a quaint Dalmatian seaside town. The city started life as a Greek colony before falling under the rule of the Romans in 228 BC, in those days it was known as Epidaurus, a name that you will often see around the town still today. The promenade is dominated by Baroque Church St. Nicholas from the 15th century; its stone spire can be used as a landmark for your day in Cavtat. Take the time to visit another Cavtat attraction, the Račić Mausoleum. The mausoleum has a prime location on top of a point on the peninsular and is the final resting place of the prominent shipping family from the town, the Račić family. The impressive building was designed and created by the famous Croatian sculptor Ivan Meštrović. The Franciscan Monastery, a five-minute walk from the mausoleum, is also well worth a visit. The church and adjoining cloisters were founded in 1481.

SGD News: Did you always want to be a pilot?

Laura: I wasn't planning to become one, but I could say that the career chose me. After university, I started to work for a company responsible for servicing police radio stations in rural areas surrounding Rome. Some locations were quite remote so flying a helicopter was the easiest way to get the job done. I joined the rides and after a while decided to become a pilot myself.

SGD News: What is the most fascinating thing aboutflying (a helicopter)?

Laura: Possibilities! There are so many beautiful spots where a plane can't go and that you can really only enjoy by helicopter. It is also a better choice for combining passion for flying with different destination experiences, from sightseeing and wine tours to island hopping and transfers.



SGD News: What has been your most memorable flight and why?

Laura: There have been so many... but if I had to pick one, I would say a flight from Rome to London. Amazing trip with breath-taking scenery and landmarks... the Alps, Lyon, Paris, London...

SGD News: What are three things you love about Croatia?

Laura: The incredible amount of colours, islands and history!

SGD News: What is the greatest challenge in running helicopter tours?

Laura: Well, safety comes first, and three major factors are weight, density altitude, and wind. Weather conditions must be ideal both at the departure point and the destination, so as a pilot I make sure the flight is safe to go.

THE SWEET SIDE OF DUBROVNIK

Dalmatian cuisine is known for its healthy, fresh and local ingredients. With the Adriatic on the doorstep and tasty, seasonal produce growing in the fields locally, using recipes handed down by generations of grandmothers, it is perhaps no surprise that the Mediterranean Diet has been inscribed as intangible UNESCO heritage.

But what happens when it goes to something a little sweeter, like desserts?

Traditional Dubrovnik desserts are delicious, and they are made from natural products. Here are a few to check out at our Maraska Lounge Bar:

Dubrovačka rozata (Dubrovnik rozata) – Dubrovnik's answer to the French crème brulee, and the perfect light finish after a fine Dalmatian meal. The best rozata is to be found in the Dubrovnik region, and although it takes quite some skill to prepare the dish, the ingredients are actually very simple – just eggs, sugar and milk. Dubrovnik Rozata has been afforded Croatian cultural heritage status – order it to find out why!

Čokoladni tart s ljutom narančom (Bitter orange chocolate tart) – Walk around the old town of Dubrovnik and you will notice a number of orange trees in the various gardens. The oranges are unusually bitter and have long been part of Dubrovnik's culinary tradition. Their bitter taste makes them not so attractive to eat as fruit, but locals are very creative, using them to make orange marmalade, orange cake, orange liqueur, orange



juice, sugared orange peel called arancini. And for chocolate lovers, the best way to try this Dubrovnik delicacy is with the traditional chocolate tart with bitter orange.

Stonska torta s bademima (Ston almond cake) – Almonds are also prevalent in Dalmatia, and they contribute perhaps to the most unusual dessert which originates from the town of Ston, just north of Dubrovnik. Famed for its salt pans, oysters and what is said to the longest fortified wall outside China, Ston also has the delightful Ston cake with almonds, which often fascinates tourists with its unusual filling – which includes pasta.



LA PATISSERIE

If you need something to satisfy your craving for sweets, La Patisserie is the place to go. Indulge in artisan ice cream and cakes, as well as a freshly brewed espresso with a glass of orange juice. And the children will thank you as they cast their eyes over the cornucopia of toppings on offer. If you get peckish in the afternoon, we have a choice of sandwiches, with bread freshly made in La Patisserie. From sandwich menu we recommend you to try Dalmatian with prosciutto, sheep milk cheese and fresh vegetables - healthy and authentic, all 100% Dubrovnik and Dalmatia.

September 2019

As part of the Year of Culture and Tourism, a traveling exhibition entitled Enthusiasm for Ink Wash Painting opened at the Museum of Modern Art Dubrovnik (MOMAD). The exhibition is intended for domestic and diverse international audiences in Dubrovnik, who will get the chance to become acquainted with the centuries-old Chinese tradition of the ink wash painting and the interpretation of this technique by contemporary artists. The goal of presenting this exhibition in Europe, far from China, the capital of ink was painting, is to introduce Europeans to this tradition of painting that shows centuries-old Chinese wisdom and to establish cultural bridges for further mutual learning. The exhibition will be open until September 22nd, 2019.

DULČIĆ MASLE PULITIKA GALLERY

September 2019

Dubrovnik is blessed with a number of art galleries to do justice to the quality of work of its painters, and art enthusiasts will have lots of fun wandering through the old town learning more about the art traditions of the city.
